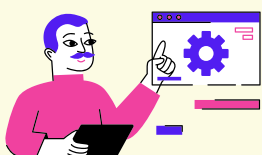


# 10 ESSENTIAL TIPS FOR MAINTAINING YOUR WORDPRESS WEBSITE

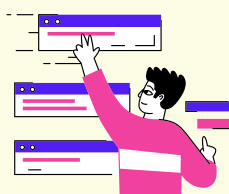


## 1. Keep WordPress Core, Themes, and Plugins Updated
